## October Newsletter

- **Oct 6 – Census Day:** Oct 6 is our annual “Census Day.” This is the day that our enrollment gets certified with the State of California and is important because it sets our per pupil funding for the year. Because of this, it is extremely important that we have our best attendance day of the entire school year. To celebrate the importance of daily school attendance **Oct 6 will be a “FREE DRESS DAY.”**
- **Classroom Showcase Week – Oct 11-Oct 15:** Due to COVID safety we will not be able to have our annual “Back to School” night. Instead, we are going to highlight each classroom throughout the week. We want all families to get to see inside their child’s classroom, and showcase all of the great learning going on in each classroom. Short videos and pictures will be posted through out the week on BLOOMz.
- **BLOOMz Contest -Oct 11-Oct 15:** BLOOMz is an extremely important communication system for PUC Milagro. It is crucial that all families are signed-up and active on BLOOMz. Classrooms that have **100% of family members signed-up** on BLOOMz by **Oct 15** will get **free dress for the entire week of Oct 18-Oct 22.**
- **iReady Testing – Oct 18-22:** All students will be tested in reading and math using our online testing and learning support program iReady the week of Oct 18-22. The results of this test will be sent home and discussed, along with your child’s September benchmark results, during Virtual Family Conferences the week of Nov 1-5. Please make sure your child attends school everyday rested and ready to do their personal best.
- **Virtual Family Conference Sign-ups Begin – Mon, Oct 18:** All families are required to attend 2 virtual family conferences (Nov and Feb). November Virtual Family conferences will be held Nov 1-Nov 5 online via Zoom or Google Meets and will last 30 minutes. Conferences will be schedule between 12:15pm-4:00pm and that week students will have minimum school days (11:45am Dismissal K-2 and 12:00pm Dismissal 3-5). Teachers will be posting conference sign-ups on BLOOMz starting Mon, Oct 18<sup>th</sup>.
- **Fun Week Oct 25-Oct 29:** Our annual Halloween Carnival has to be modified for COVID safety (sorry no families on campus). Because of this we are adding a week of fun dress-up days.
