## PANELISTS - Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- What is PUC Career Convos Webinar series purpose?  
PUC Career Convos 10-week webinar series will help students explore, evaluate and learn the clear steps to pursue their career choice.
- How long is a webinar?  
Webinars are 1-hour in length.
- How many expert panelists will participate in a webinar?  
We are recruiting between 2-4 panelist, ranging in a variety of careers within the career/field
- What is the tone of PUC Career Convo webinars?  
We are shooting for a comfortable and professional conversation (hence Career Convos name ;-)
- What platform will the webinars use? Zoom
- Why are you asking for consent to record the Zoom webinar, and what if I or my organization doesn't consent to being recorded?  
- We will post webinar recordings to a PUC Career Convos Webinar Series webpage, allowing students and teachers to access recordings.  
- If you/your organization does not consent to being recorded, you can still participate and we will not record the webinar.
- Who is the primary webinar audience?  
PUC Schools' 7 middle schools and 5 high schools located throughout Northeast San Fernando Valley and Northeast Los Angeles. Students' ages range between 11-18 years old. We promote the webinars on social media and email, so we may have some parents/guardians, PUC alumni and members of the community also in attendance.
- Can anyone attend these webinars?  
Yes, we welcome anyone and everyone to join the Convo! Feel free to promote in your networks.
- How many students do we anticipate in attendance?  
Audiences can range between 20 - 100+.
- Will the webinar participants/students have the opportunity to ask questions?  
Yes, participants may ask questions prior to the webinar through their webinar registration, and during the webinar through Zoom chat.
- What do I need to do to prepare as a panelist?  
- Have Zoom ready to go on your computer prior to the webinar.  
- Think about your responses to the following questions (Questions verbally asked & posted on slides):
  - How you figured out what you wanted to be / how you found your career match
  - What is the required education/training for your profession
  - Valuable insight about your daily work (Reality of expectations, work environment, work-life balance, competitiveness, etc.)
  - Projected industry/field outlook (job growth, changes, challenges, etc.)
  - What you/your organization is looking for when hiring candidate
  - What you would tell yourself career-wise if you could go back in time to speak to your 9th grade self?
  - Greatest lessons learned from mistakes and successes
- Log on to the webinar at a minimum of 5 minutes prior to the 5:00pm (PST) start time
