We are pleased to inform you that *your school* will be implementing a new option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for 2020-21 School Year.

Schools that participate in CEP are able to provide healthy breakfasts **and** lunches each day at no charge for **all** students enrolled at PUC School during the 2020-2021 School Year.

This means that all PUC School students are eligible to receive FREE breakfast and lunch meals. If you would like to pick up meals for your child during the COVID-19 school closures, please follow the Food Distribution schedule listed below.
