PRESENTATION TIPS:

- **Bring your laptop if you plan on using a computer for your presentation**
- Visual aids are helpful (Video, photos, PPT/Slideshow, brochures, etc.)
- Make your presentation interactive (i.e. - Ask students questions, create an activity to get them involved, etc.)
